I will go to the beach if the sun comes out.

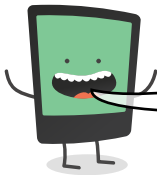
You can go out to play when your work is done.

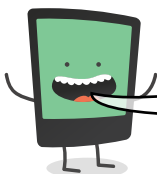
