I can turn adjectives into adverbs.

Adjectives modify (or change) nouns and adverbs modify adjectives, verbs and adverbs. It is possible to change adjectives into adverbs. Generally speaking, this is done by adding '-ly'. Take a look at the example.	
Nervous as an adjective	Nervously as an adverb
The nervous boy jumped into the pool.	Nervously the boy jumped into the pool.
