

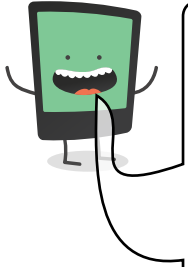

I can identify active sentences.

To identify active sentences we need to understand these terms:

- verb - the state or action taking place
- agent - the person or thing that is **doing** the verb
- subject - the person or thing the sentence is about. The subject comes before the verb

Find these word classes in each sentence below.
If the **subject is also the agent**, the sentence is active.
