

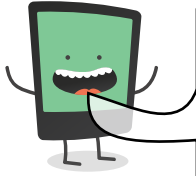

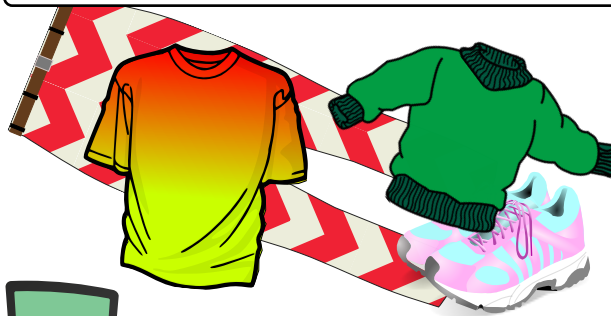
I can use commas in more complicated lists.

In my basket I have chocolate and toffee ice-cream oranges lemon and lime fruit juice and bananas.

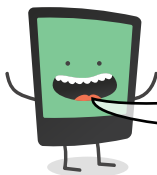
